

Easter Craft

Supplies: Paper plate Cotton balls Glue Scissors Black construction paper Googly eyes Black marker



- 1. Trace a sheep's head, four rectangles and a small circle onto the black construction paper with your marker.
- 2. Use scissors to cut out the shapes .
- 3. Decorate the sheep's face with a nose and mouth and googly eyes.
- 4. Glue cotton balls onto the paper plate.
- 5. Glue sheep head, legs and tail onto the sheep.
