Get Snacking

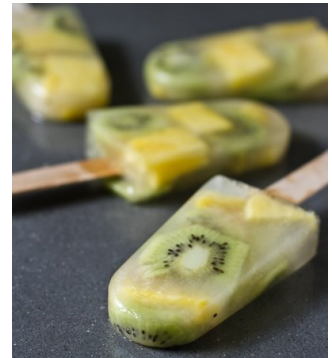
Coconut Pineapple Kiwi Real Fruit Popsicles
