Baked Potato Fundraiser

The Chambers County 4-H Council and Adult Leaders Associations hosted a Baked Potato Fundraiser on March 22, 2017. Baked Potato plates were sold to Chambers County Employees and other Anahuac-based businesses. Many 4-Hers and parents from across the county came out to help prepare and deliver the potatoes.

In total, more than \$900 (profit) was raised for the 2017 Chambers County 4-H Banquet, community service projects and to provide scholarships for leadership camps.



2017 Chambers County SALE Shoot Results

Both Marsh Maniacs and Chambers County 4-H Shooting Club were represented by members at the San Antonio Livestock Exhibition shotgun shoot.

Marsh Maniacs took 17 team members to the competition and all who attended shot a personal best in at least one of the majors events that they participated in. Nine shooters qualified to shoot in the finals with five of those kiddos winning BIG:

- Jo Vavra—won a gun in the Lewis Class for Trap
- Tanner Ramsey—fourth in Lewis Class for Trap, won a buckle, gun and case of ammo
- Brandon Miller—fourth place in age group for Sporting Clays, won a buckle, gun and two cases of ammo
- Chailey Wilchek—fourth place in girls open division for Sporting Clays, won a \$10,000 scholarship and a buckle
- Jonathan Goedrich— third place Super Sporting, second in his age group for Sporting Clays, won first leg of the Junior PSCA Championship, won a two buckles, two guns, ammo, a \$10,000 scholarship and a \$1,750 scholarship

Logan Lotz from the Chambers County 4-H Shooting Club also participated at the SALE shooting competition. Logan placed second in the PSCA Qualifier, second in Super Sporting, and second in the main Sporting Clays event. Logan won two buckles, a medal and two guns.
