On September 23 the County Council elected their 2014-2015 Officer Panel. Officers are as follows:





- December 8, 2014—Lamb, Goat, Swine and F1 Heifer entries due to Extension Office
- December 8, 2014—Turkey Pickup at YMBL Office from 4 to 6 p.m.
- February 3, 2015—Rabbit entry deadline
- February 11, 2015—Broiler Pickup at YMBL Office from 4 to 6 p.m.

Exhibitors should bring a box to pick up all poultry.
